



We provide anti-viral Kleenexes and hand sanitizers throughout the church. We sanitize faucets, sinks, water fountains and toilets. Backs of the pews and arms of pews, hand railings, doorknobs, door handles, and light switches are cleaned. We sanitize countertops, tables, chairs and soft chairs with arms. We also spray rooms with Lysol as needed. Other cleaning is done as well, but we wanted to assure you these are some of the things we are paying close attention to for the health of our community.



Community Dinner Report 2019-2020

Yes, we are striving to build ministry. By providing community dinners on Wednesdays from September through May we have served 2840 meals. We took a four week break mid-March to mid-April, but we continued to serve with 'Take-Out Meals Only' through the end of May meeting the needs of the children, youth and families in our community. For 2840 total meals it cost \$5923.43 with \$4682.39 donations given. The church's cost was \$1295.04. This figures out to be \$2.09 per meal costing the church only \$.46 per meal. Blessings for all. Thanks be to God for this wonderful ministry. We are nurturing body, mind and spirit in our own back yard. May God continue to show us how to serve one another in the name of Jesus Christ.
