Thank You All for the comforting cards, phone calls and e-mails I have received to this point. I will be receiving radiation treatments for skin cancer; it's 100% treatable and will be followed by cataract surgery. When treatments begin (after wading through all the red tape), I will have to go to Lima every day for four or five weeks. It's very expensive but all the costs are covered except lab work and the surgery. I cannot speak highly enough of the team of doctors involved in my care; they are the best!
