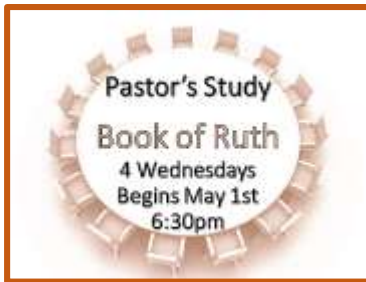


Henderson Settlement Project: If you would like to help the HSP team purchase food and hygiene. Blue HSP envelopes can be found in the café.
