Statement of Covenant: As a Christian community of faith and a United Methodist congregation, we pledge to conduct the ministry of the gospel in ways that assure the safety and spiritual growth of all our children, youth, and vulnerable adults, as well as those who work with these populations.

The Safe Sanctuary Committee met recently for the purpose of reviewing the RUMC Safe Sanctuary Policy. The committee has agreed to add some important pieces to the policy. This will be presented to the administrative board in July for approval. At that time, the Year 2 training will take place for those who completed the church training in August 2025. Contact will be made with those involved. Anyone “new” to working with children, youth, and vulnerable adults will be contacted soon for information on the policy training and background checks.
