

Over the past few months, the regular attenders of Van Wert Bethel United Methodist church under the leadership of Pastor Greg Wack have discussed the best options for the future of this congregation. While the church has had a heart to serve and give to missions, it has experienced notable barriers to growth and has continued to decline in attendance for many years. In consultation with our District Superintendent, Rev. Barry Burns, the leadership of Bethel has decided that the current path is no longer sustainable.

The Bethel UMC leadership expressed interest in merging with First UMC as the best option to continue to use the assets of Bethel church for ministry in the local area. Barry Burns consulted with me about this possibility. I assembled a small team of leaders to have an initial meeting with our brothers and sisters at Bethel and the D.S. Pastor Chris; Warren Foy, Board of Trustee chair; Al Morris, Finance Team Rep; Jana Thompson, Membership Secretary; and Dillon Staas IV, Attorney explored this proposal. We discerned to move forward with the next steps. At our March 28 Administrative Board meeting this team reported this proposal for their consideration and support to continue the process of negotiating the "Memorandum of Understanding" for the Merger of the Bethel UMC and First UMC. The Board authorized them to continue the process. Copies of the proposed Memorandum of Understanding are at both


