BEING NEIGHBORLY

Shoeboxes for Operation Christmas Child:

- When you are ready to shop for your shoe box, decide the age and gender of the child for whom you want to shop. That will help you focus on the types of products to seek out.
- Pray about what to pick for the child. Remember that most of these children are unfamiliar with anything that kids in the western cultures are surrounded by, so there is no need to pay more for a "Frozen" coloring book (as an example) when a generic book will make the child just as happy!
