

Shoeboxes for Operation Christmas Child:

- There is no need to include the \$10 shipping and handling fee with your box. Your donations to missions in August helps cover that cost. However, if you want to donate, to cover boxes from others, you can do so online at Samaritanspurse.org or make a check out to our church and put Shoe Boxes on the memo line! We will send one donation for all of our boxes.
 - Be sure to tape your label to the box lid. Put tape on all the edges. Those boxes travel tens of thousands of miles and they need to be affixed firmly! And mark the age your box was packed for, on the label.
