The donor cannot have diabetes, kidney disease, cancer, HIV, uncontrolled high blood pressure, or be a transplant recipient. A donor must be at least 18 and preferably younger than 70. The cost of donating a kidney is covered by my insurance. The donor is in the hospital for three to five days and only experiences minor discomfort. The procedure will most likely take place in Toledo.

Who knows? My donor could be sitting next to me at church because GOD IS GOOD ALL THE TIME. ALL THE TIME, GOD IS GOOD.


